WHAT WILL TAKE PLACE BEFORE TEACHING IN THE CLASSROOM?

History curriculum has been redesigned to follow a chronological narrative throughout the school. It is a skills based scheme of work, through which the knowledge will be taught.

HOW WILL THIS BE MEASURED?

The whole school will be following the new history curriculum. Focus on teaching skills to teach the knowledge. · Repetition of skills to build independence. Skills to progress through the year groups. Children to retain information and recall their knowledge in other lessons. A simple but effective assessment system to help keep track of progression through the academic year.
