Introduction

At Phoenix Primary School we believe that smart school uniform is essential to support effective development of a positive learning ethos and to support the highest educational expectations.

Uniform

School uniform consists of:

- White cotton school shirt, with a School tie.
- *School jumper, with school logo.
- Black school trousers or skirt.
- Plain black school shoes, or plain black plimsolls (no other type of footwear is permitted in school, with the exception of PE*).
- White or black socks/tights

P.E Kit

P.E. Kit consists of:

- Plain white tee-shirt.
- Plain black shorts.
- Training shoes can be worn for outdoor PE lessons.

*School jumpers/cardigans with logo are available from Schooltime, Railway Street, Chatham. All other items of school uniform are available from many outlets including supermarkets etc.

It is expected that pupils attend school wearing full uniform every day, including appropriate shoes. At times, however, the school may waive the expectation to wear uniform for a special occasion i.e. charity or fundraising event, but these will be notified to parents in advance. Where the school offers a 'non-uniform' day, parents may still send their children to school in uniform if they wish, however, the school will not allow football tops or jeans to be worn.

Jewellery

A single Gold or Silver stud or small hoop in each ear may be worn in school. These have to be removed by the student when taking part in PE or Physical lessons. It is advised that any piercings are undertaken at the beginning of the Summer break to avoid issues of removal.

Religious Jewellery will be considered on an individual basis by the Head teacher.

A child friendly watch may be worn; however this is at the risk of the parents/carers.

Hair

Student's hair should be of their natural colour and shaved symbols or patterns are advised to be undertaken in the holidays to allow for full growth by the time they come into school. Hair should be tied up and bows are to be kept under 7cm's in length.

EYFS UNIFORM

- White polo shirt
- *School jumper, with school logo
- Black school trousers or skirt
- Plain black school shoes, or plain black plimsolls (no other type of footwear is permitted in school, with the exception of PE*)
- White or black socks/tights

If there are parents encountering financial hardships and are having difficulty with uniform they can approach the school in confidence.

The school regularly recycles uniform which is available on the playground and at parent days.

This policy will be updated annually.
